

PROCESS OF ACCEPTING DOGS INTO A REGISTER:

1. People interested in registering their non pedigree dogs should sign up their dog for Bonitace Evaluation. Dog should have a **chip & examined patellas**. Dogs can join Bonitace from the age of 12 months.
2. During Bonitace it will be determined whether the dog will or will not be accepted for further process of Register Acceptance. Bonitace respects valid **Breed Standard & Regulations for Acceptance of Dogs into a Register**.
3. After successfully passed Bonitace the dog will attend two dog shows. Only a Club or Special Shows are permitted. The dog will have a chance to show itself at the **end of the show**.

It is necessary to be assessed twice by an International Judge. The dog will then receive a number of a Helping Register & can start breeding. (These are strict requirements for Helping Registers as stated under ČMKU rules!!)

4. After attending two required dog shows you should forward the show results together with a patellas examination document, a confirmation about chipping & an application form for acceptance into a register to the main breed advisor.
5. When you receive a confirmation that your dog has been accepted into the helping register you should apply for a mating list. **Please enclose a copy of a document confirming your dog's acceptance into the register**. Only mating list confirmed by the main breed adviser will be accepted.
6. Whole first litter must go through bonitace. Should the first litter die the offsprings of the second litter **must** be evaluated at Bonitace. If the owner of the registered dog doesn't make this possible, he or she will not be granted another mating list - therefore the bitch will not be allowed to breed puppies with Pedigree Papers.
7. Excluding faults of the offsprings can lead to a request to evaluate another litter. Should all the offsprings from the first litter be evaluated as unsuitable with excluding faults no future mating lists would be issued. This would mean an end of the dogs' breeding.
8. Dogs from helping register will only be recommended to mate with perfect dogs with full pedigree. We will not always recommend to mate according to „colour“ - this will increase the number of hererozygotes in the litter & Krysařík as a breed will stay more uniform.
